


Cheese blocks have been

## What is Kentucky Cheese Cares?

It is a partnership between Kentucky Dairy farmers, the Kentucky Department of Agriculture, The Dairy Alliance, Kentucky Center for Agriculture and Rural Development, Kroger, Feeding America and Feeding Kentucky. The program was established in October of 2020 to increase access to dairy products while supporting Kentucky dairy farmers.

## What does it do?


Cheese Cares allows Kroger customers to purchase locally made, artisanal cheese while supporting the mission of Feeding Kentucky.


## Who participates?

Cheese cares is a Cause Marketing
Program allowing Kroger customers who
purchase Wildcat Mountain Cheese or
Harvest Moon Cheese from one of the
participating Kroger stores, 50 cents is
donated to Feeding Kentucky.

There are over 50 Kroger locations across the state that sell the participating cheeses.

For every block of cheese sold from participating local dairies, Kroger donates 50 cents to Feeding Kentucky. In turn, Feeding Kentucky uses those funds to purchase cheese from Kentucky dairies to be distributed across the Commonwealth.
